## **Terms & Conditions:**

- 1) Payment Terms-
- a) Billing shall be made for the work done on monthly basis; Interim payments shall be made within 40 days of each approved monthly Bill by the Project Manager of MEIL after the execution of the works as per the approved measurements of Joint Measurement Certificate duly certified by Site Engineer of MEIL.
- b) There shall not be any escalation or variation in rates, the above work order rates shall be firm for entire period of completion of the work.
- c) The quantities stated in the BOQ are tentative, it may increase or decrease as per the site conditions, requirement, plans and profile. The payment will be made as per the actual quantities & measurement ascertained in accordance with above clause 2. (a) at site.
- d) Any revision / change in the laws shall be applicable to the Contractor without any financial implications to the MEIL
- 2) Applicable Taxes-

Income Tax (TDS) as per the rate in force from time to time shall be deducted from the gross bill of each bill.

- 3) Retention Money to be deducted from Bills &its Release
- 5 % will be deducted from each monthly Bill towards Retention Money and the same shall be released after material reconciliation and successful completion of defects liability period.
- 4) Other applicable deductions
- a) If Diesel Supplied by MEIL to the contractor, the cost of Diesel will be debited at the rate of Rs.99/- per liter.
- b) Diesel will be supplied based on the progress of work at the rate of 0.8 lit/curn .As an example if the progress of earthwork is 3,000 cum per day accordingly the diesel will be given at 2400 liters/day.
- 5) Scope of work
- a) The scope of work shall be excavating, area filling, grading and compacting soils for the area designated on the drawing. The work shall include clearing and leveling the top soil including excavation, hauling, dumping & spreading of the soil, under cutting to remove the unstable soil areas,
- b)compacting existing soil surfaces and bottom of the excavated areas to receive fills, compacting the excavated surface for sub grade, placing and compacting in fills, cleaning the surface water and areas to be filled dry, final grading of designated areas, disposing of unsuitable and excess excavated materials and other incidental items for finished item of work thereof.
- c) Excavation, Loading, Transportation with approved material from Borrow pits with lead of 01 KM. The Lead rate for 1km as at the rate of Rs. 10/-per cum .The part KM rate for every 0.250 km shall be calculated on Pro-rate basis.
- d) Construction of Sub Grade satisfying the requirements of minimum 10% CBR with approved material. Complete as per the standards & specification of MorTH (5th Revision) and relevant IRC & IS code Provision.
- 6) Rate basis and deductions.

All prices are inclusive of TDS and all other costs for the finished product and as per rate condition, but exclusive of Labour cess & Seigniorage charges/ Royalty,GST, all other taxes, levies and duties

7) Manner of execution-

Contractor shall arrange adequate and suitable machinery and manpower required for the timely and successful completion of the works and Contractor shall ensure adequate care for their welfare and well being. Further the Contractor shall not engage any child labour.

8)Defect liability Period: will be for 06 months from the date of completion.

- 9) Conditions for Deployment of Manpower, their Safety, and compliance with Statutory Obligation
- a) The Contract
- b) or shall arrange for adequate and suitable experienced/ skilled manpower and staff required for the timely and successful completion of the works and Contractor shall ensure adequate care for their welfare and well-being.
- c) Contractor shall obtain labour license and PF account well in advance before commencement of the job. The first interim bill shall be released only on submission of a copy of labour license and on compliance of rules made under different labour laws. If labour license is not applicable, the contractor shall obtain a confirmation to this effect from local authorities of Labour Department.
- d) Contractor shall deposit its employees#/workmen#s PF contribution to PF Authority as per the rules of P.F Act.
- e) At its cost, the contractor shall provide all personal protection equipment (PPE)/ safety appliances like dust masks, safety barication wherever required, sign boards at Road Diversions and at required places, safety belt, ladder, safety shoes, helmet, hand gloves, safety goggles, rain gears, Overalls etc., to their personnel working inside the project sites at his cost and should adhere to safety requirements
- 10) Compliance with Labour Laws

The Contractor shall observe all provisions of labour laws / acts & rules made thereunder enacted either by Central 60vl. and / or State Govt. of Andhra Pradesh or as applicable to these works as well as safety rules and regulations of the project. Contractor shall also be responsible for the good conduct of its subcontractors, agencies, workmen etc.

11) Insurance: The Contractor shall take care that its workmen and labor are insured properly in accordance with Laws. Contractor shall be required to take the

following insurances in connection with the works, the cost of which will have to be borne by the Contractor.

- a) Workmen#s Compensation Insurance;
- b) Plant, Equipment and Machinery Insurance;
- c) Vehicle Insurances/ automobile liability insurance policy.
- d) Any other insurance deemed necessary by the Contractor or required by applicable law.
- 12) Contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified the MEIL against any law suits, actions, demands, loss, costs and expenses that may accrue/devolve upon the MEIL on account of Contractor#s noncompliance with labor laws and rules mentioned
- 13) Safety and Security

All the safety & security regulations prevailing at site will have to be strictly complied and adhered to by the Contractor and also by its labor engaged on site.

- 14) Other Conditions of Commencement & Completion of works
- a) The Contractor has thoroughly understood the scope of work and is obliged to complete the works within the time period of 12 months. The Contractor shall arrange adequate resources including men, material and machinery at each & every stage of works, in time, to adhere to the time schedule.
- b) Effective Date of the work order: This effective date of this work order shall commence from 01.05.2024.
- 15) Settlement of Disputes

If the parties hereto should fail to settle such differences or disputes by extensive mutual discussions and agreement as per within 20 days of the notice of such

dispute thereof, the same shall be referred to the Courts located in Hyderabad / Ranga Reddy District for the reason that the cause of action for all such dispute shall be deemed to have been arose in Hyderabad/Ranga Reddy District. Prepared By
